Community Profile

Cascade is a beautiful village within the 30,000-acre Kettle Moraine State Forest and is home to the 112-acre Lake Ellen. An outdoor enthusiast's dream, this quaint town offers several sportsmen's clubs, a winery, and wonderful restaurants. With the construction of two 100-kilowatt wind turbines in June 2010, the Village of Cascade became the first community in Wisconsin to use locally produced wind energy to power its municipal wastewater treatment plant.



Government Structure

The Village of Cascade operates under the laws of the State of Wisconsin. The Board consists of the Village President and six trustees. The members of the Board of Trustees are elected at large by the Village of Cascade's registered voters to serve two-year staggered terms. As elected officials, the Village Board is responsible to the residents of Cascade. The Board adopts ordinances, resolutions, budgets, goals, and policies of the Village.

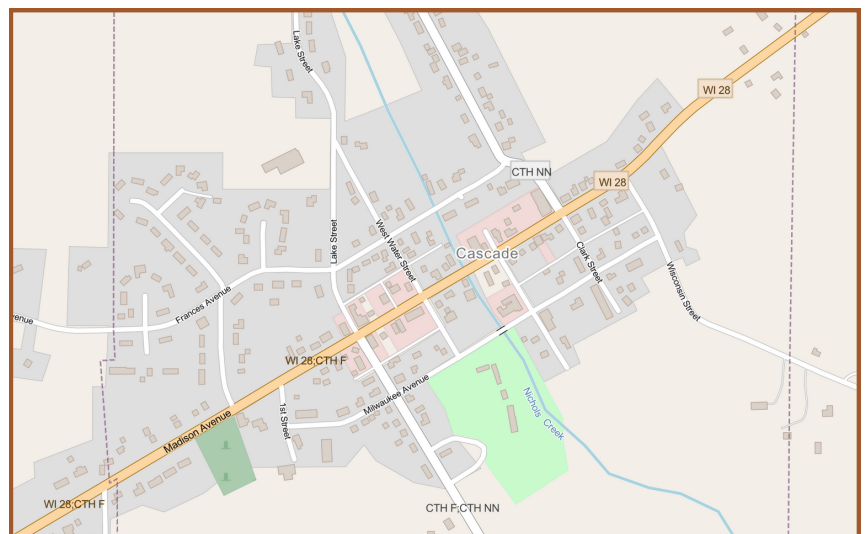
